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## Biographical / Historical

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These papers primarily describe the lives of Annie E. Wood (1831-1879), John G. Webb (1823-1904), and their descendants. Annie E. Wood was the daughter of Edith "Edy" Wood, an emancipated Black woman living in North Carolina who engaged in a romantic relationship with James Cathcart Johnston, a white planter. Annie and her sister Mary Virginia Wood were both born in North Carolina, although their father paid for both girls and their mother to relocate to Philadelphia in 1833, shortly after Annie's birth. She worked as a teacher and later married John G. Webb.

John was the son of Francis Webb and Louisa Burr (illegitimate daughter of Vice President Aaron Burr). He worked as both a farmer and a barber. He traveled to California prior to his marriage in search of gold, and was separated from his wife and six children in the wake of the Civil War as he sought work across the country.

Although the family was never wealthy, they were part of the educated and religiously devout mixed-race and African-American elite in the greater Philadelphia area. All five daughters

trained as teachers. They were related by birth and marriage to many other prominent African-American families, including author Frank J. Webb, Louisa Jacobs (daughter of memoirist Harriet Jacobs), the Fortens, and the Grimkés. In addition to their home in Philadelphia, the family owned some farmland and property in Camden, New Jersey.

Other family members represented in these papers include:

Edith "Edie" Louise Webb (1855-1912), eldest daughter of Annie and John. Edith graduated from the Institute for Colored Youth, and worked as both a teacher and a private nurse.

Eugenie "Genie" Webb (1856-1919). Eugenie was educated at the Institute for Colored Youth and worked as a teacher in various schools, alongside her sisters Edith and Miriam. Further information on Eugenie and her correspondence with Louisa Jacobs, as well as transcriptions of some letters, can be found in the book *Whispers of Cruel Wrongs: The Correspondence of Louisa Jacobs and Her Circle, 1879-1911* by Mary Maillard, available in the LCP reading room.

John D. Webb (1863-1934), also known as Juan de Gonzalez, third child and only son of Annie and John G. Webb. John D. Webb left the Philadelphia area in 1892, leaving his first wife and two daughters behind, and was partially estranged from his family for some time. Named John Johnston Webb at birth, he also used the names John Degonzalez Webb and Juan de Gonzalez in order to pass as white.

Miriam "Mame" D. Webb Hegamin (1865-1942). Miriam married William Waters Hegamin II (1859-1942), who was also related by marriage to the Fortens, and together they had five children. Three of their children appear in the Correspondence series of this collection: Cordelia "Deedee" Hegamin (1891-1980), William Hegamin III (1893-1964), and Miriam Hegamin Thomas (1904-1997).

Charlotte Cordelia "Blink" Webb (1868-1912). Charlotte worked as a teacher and, following the death of her father in 1904, lived primarily in Philadelphia with her unmarried sisters.

Ada Virgil Webb Simons (1872-1952), sixth and youngest of Annie and John. Her mother died of consumption when she was only seven, leaving Ada and Charlotte to be raised primarily by their two eldest sisters. Ada married Reverend John Henry Simons (1866-1925). Although the couple did not have children, both were frequent correspondents with various nieces and nephews from the Simons and Hegamin families.

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## Scope and Contents

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The collection has been divided into three series.

The first contains Biographical documents. The majority of these are religious documents, such as baptismal records, although it also includes some material related to the teaching careers of the Webb sisters.

The bulk of the collection is contained in the Correspondence series. Letters are first grouped by family member, then by sent/received, and finally by chronological order. Please note correspondence within the family is stored according to original order as much as possible—this has resulted in, for example, some letters sent by Miriam Webb Hegamin and received by John D. Webb being stored with her correspondence, while others are stored with his, according to how they were received. This series has been described item-by-item to assist in locating these documents.

The majority of this correspondence is personal in nature and describes the daily lives of the Wood-Webb family. Of particular interest are love letters between Annie Wood Webb and John G. Webb from 1854, extensive correspondence between Eugenie Webb and Louisa Jacobs, and Ada Webb Simons' correspondence with members of the Simons family, several of whom lived in the Bahamas and Trinidad and Tobago.

The third series is Financial/Legal records. These include deeds and documents about real estate transactions, regular banking, and funeral costs. A limited amount of business correspondence can be found in this series, as well as condolence letters.

An oversize box contains three documents: Charlotte Cordelia Webb's teaching certificate, Reverend John Henry Simons' ordination certificate, and a real estate record belonging to John G. Webb. An abstract of title belonging to Ada Webb Simons has been temporarily removed from the collection until custom housing can be provided.
